PhD in Behavioural Ecotoxicology

- Student will enroll in the PhD program in the Department of Biology
- Student will conduct research on the effects of petrochemicals on behaviour of aquatic vertebrates
- Research will be based at a new outdoor ecotoxicological facility at the Queen's University Biological Station
- Assets: knowledge of animal behaviour, aquatic ecology, and/or ecotoxicology; training in statistics; scientific writing skills
- Guaranteed stipend: \$24,300/yr



MES in Contaminant Biogeochemistry

- Student will enroll in the 20-month Master's of Environmental Studies program (6 courses and a report)
- Student will analyze an existing data set on the environmental fate of a contaminant in freshwater lakes

- Guaranteed stipend: \$14,000/yr
